Eola Does Burgundy - 2010:

Day One: Arrive in Paris: As is our custom, the tour begins with a "get acquainted" wine reception, mixer and orientation at our hotel. This will give everyone the opportunity to get acquainted with one another and relax after the flight.

Day Two: After a good night's rest, we will start our day with a three hour morning tour of city highlights. Paris is a beautiful city with lots of history and things to do. After we get the lay of the land, we will have the afternoon on our own to visit up close the many sights of Paris including the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, Champs Elysees the Louvre Museum and more.

Day Three: Today we head off the famous Versailles Palace, home of the Bourbon kings and seat of power in the glory days of France. The afternoon will be capped of with a glass of Champagne aboard a river cruse of the Seine. Evening is free for more sighthseeing.

Day Four: Today will be travel day as we board our bus and head to Champagne country and the city of Reims. We will tour the famous Cathedral where Kings were crowned and one of the best examples of Gothic architecture in Western Europe. Oh

yes, since we are here, why not visit a famous Champagne house for some wine tasting? After a full day, we will return to Paris for a good night's rest.

Day Five: Destination Burgundy! We say adios to Paris and head out to the heart of Burgundy, home of some great Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Our bus will zip along farm country roads passing such legendary wine towns like Vosne-Romanee, Gevery Chambertin, Pommard, and Puligny. Our final destination for the next few days is Beaune situated in the heart of Burgundy and a perfect spot to launch our wine excursions.

Day Six: Today we explore along the wine road passing small villages and miles of vineyards. This will be a chance to sample some great Chardonnay wines... and yes, we will have to learn how to say in French, "These wines are almost as good as Eola Hills" In the afternoon we will visit the Hospice de Beaune and have the evening free to relax and stroll around town.

Day Seven: This day will be an excursion to Dijon, the food capitol of France. We have the option of take a French cooking class (more details to follow) and then the afternoon we will visit the estate of the Dukes of Burgundy that houses the Fine Arts Museum. We might even find ourselves in a local mustard boutique for some tasting..... Pardon me, but do you have any grey poupon???

Day Eight: Beaune to Lyon: Today we continue to head south to Lyon, France's second largest city and a real gastronomic center. The short hop will be concluded with a sightseeing tour of the city then after check-in, a chance just to relax, window shop or take a quick nap. Tonight we will have a bon voyage dinner and a chance to say goodbye to friends both old and new.

Day Nine: Rise and shine as today the tour officially ends and we say goodbye to old friends and some new ones too.

A deposit of \$250 is required upon sign-up with balance due on or before 90 days prior to departure. (See refund policy)

Cancellation:

Since Eola Hills has to make financial commitments to hotels, bus companies and other businesses, after a certain date refunds are not always available. Please read and be sure you understand the following policy regarding cancellations:

Up to 90 days full refund less \$50.00

89-60 days: full refund less deposit

59-31 days: full refund less 30% of total price

30 days or less: no refund

Travel Documents:

All international travelers are required to have a valid passport when traveling to Europe. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond final date of travel.

Baggage Allowance

Air carriers are becoming stricter about size and weight on luggage. Also, due to limited space on Tour coach, no more than one bag and one carry-on per person is allowed. Please check with your air carrier for weight and dimensions required on baggage. Also, you will be handling and responsible for you own luggage. We recommend traveling light as possible. A couple of the hotels may not have elevators.

Not included in Price:

As stated above, the above price does not include air fare. Breakfast *is* included at you hotel each morning. There will be some special wine -paired meals and an evening meal on the final day in Lyon included in your trip. All other meals *are not* included. Also anything not listed above such as laundry, mini bar, telephone, alcohol, optional excursions or classes, tips for baggage or tour guides.

Traveling to France, like travel anywhere has certain risks and responsibilities. We suggest that travelers consider looking into travel insurance to cover unforeseen trip cancellations or additional costs.
